ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
RENUMBERING AND CREATING RULES

.....
 IN THE MATTER of renumbering ss. NR 20.03(1)(a)6., (c)3. and (d)4. and creating ss. NR 20.03(1)(a)6., (c)3. and (d)4. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code (as affected by Natural Resources Board Order No. F-4-84) pertaining to closure of the fishing season for predacious fish in Round Lake, Waushara County.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rule is essential to a study being conducted by the Bureau of Research. The rule closes the fishing season for northern pike, walleye, and largemouth bass in Round Lake, Waushara County.

The study is designed to determine the effects protection of predacious gamefish populations will have on slow-growing panfish. The hypothesis is that the closure of the gamefish season will augment the gamefish populations, which in turn will improve the panfish population size structure through predation.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 23.09(2)(intro.) and (k), 29.174(2)(a) and 227.014(2), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby renumbers and creates rules interpreting ss. 23.09(2)(intro.) and (k), and 29.174(2)(a), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(a)6. (c)3. and (d)4 (as affected by Natural Resources Board Order No. F-4-84) are renumbered NR 20.03(1)(a)7., (c)4. and (d)5.

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(a)6. is created to read:


The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1986.


