# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating s. NR 20.02(1)(d)1. and 2. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to trout and salmon sport fishing on the Great Lakes and Green Bay

F-14-85

#### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rule reduces the lake trout daily bag limit from 3 to 2 fish, establishes an 8-month closed season for lake trout in Green Bay and most of Lake Michigan, and closes the lake trout season in a spawning and nursery area between Algoma and the Sturgeon Bay ship canal. No changes are made in the rules for Lake Superior.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 29.085, 29.174(2)(a), and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting ss. 23.09(2)(intro.), 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats., as follows:
