AN ORDER to amend RL 4.03(2)(intro.) and repeal and recreate RL 4.04(1) and (2), relating to examination and refund fees.

Analysis prepared by the department of regulation and licensing.

ANALYSIS

In this order, the department of regulation and licensing amends s. RL 4.03(2) and repeals and recreates s. RL 4.04 to specify fees for examination and revise fees for reexamination in conformity with the fee schedule for examination specified in s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29.

The amendment to s. RL 4.03(2) indicates that an applicant who fails to take an examination will receive as a refund all but \$20 of the examination fee. The rule interprets s. 440.06, Stats., relating to refund of fees.

Section RL 4.04, as proposed for repeal and recreation, specifies in sub. (1) the minimum examination fee and refers to columns listed in the rule which indicate the name and the initial fee for a complete examination or for parts of an examination required for an original license, permit, certificate or registration. Subsection (2) of s. RL 4.04 specifies the amount of the minimum reexamination fee and refers to columns listed in the rule which indicate the fee required for taking less than a complete examination or for retaking a one-part examination. The rule interprets s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, relating to examination fees.

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the department of regulation and licensing in ss. 227.014(2)(a) and 440.06, Stats., and s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, the department of regulation and licensing hereby amends, repeals and recreates and adopts rules, interpreting s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, and s. 440.06, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Ch. RL 4(title) is amended to read:

CHAPTER RL 4 EXAMINATION AND REFUND FEES

SECTION 2. RL 4.03(2)(intro.) is amended to read:

RL 4.03(2) An applicant who fails to take an examination ~~will~~ shall receive a refund of ~~half~~ all but \$20 of the examination fee if:

SECTION 3. RL 4.04 is repealed and recreated to read:

RL 4.04 EXAMINATION FEES. (1) The minimum examination fee is \$40. The fee for a complete examination or examination parts for an original license, permit, certificate or registration is shown in column 3 of figure 4.04(3). The total initial fee is the sum of the initial fees for the parts required, but no less than \$40.

(2) The minimum reexamination fee is \$20. The fee for retaking less than a complete examination or for retaking a one-part examination is shown in column 4 of figure 4.04(3).

(3) The fees for examinations and reexaminations required by the department are as follows: (See figure 4.04(3).)
