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

ORDER OF THE  
STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION  
REPEALING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

1 To repeal PI 18.03(1)(e); to renumber PI 18.03(1)(a), (b), (c), (d), and (f); to renumber  
2 and amend PI 18.03(1)(g); and to amend PI 18.03(1)(intro.) and PI 18.05(1)(intro.),  
3 relating to high school graduation standards.

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Analysis Provided by the Department of Public Instruction

1985 Wisconsin Act 29 amended s. 118.33, Stats., relating to high school graduation standards. The requirement for 0.5 credit in computer science was removed and the required 0.5 credit in health, which had been previously required in high school, may now be completed in grades 7-12. The July 1, 1988, required date for school districts to submit their school board policies on high school graduation was changed to September 1, 1986. This proposed amendment to Chapter PI 18 will bring the rule into compliance with s. 118.33, Stats., as amended.

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4 Pursuant to the authority vested in the department of public instruction by  
5 s. 118.33(2), Stats., the state superintendent hereby repeals, renumbers, renumbers  
6 and amends, and amends rules interpreting s. 118.33, Stats., as follows:

7 SECTION 1. PI 18.03(1)(intro.) is amended to read:

8 PI 18.03(1) COURSE REQUIREMENTS. Beginning September 1, 1988, a board may  
9 not grant a high school diploma to any pupil unless the pupil has earned :

10 (a) Earned a minimum of ~~13.5~~ 12.5 credits in ~~the high school~~ grades 9 to 12  
11 as follows:

12 SECTION 2. PI 18.03(1)(a), (b), (c), and (d) are renumbered PI 18.03(1)(a) 1., 2., 3.,  
13 and 4.

14 SECTION 3. PI 18.03(1)(e) is repealed.

15 SECTION 4. PI 18.03(1)(f) is renumbered PI 18.03(1)(a)5.

16 SECTION 5. PI 18.03(1)(g) is renumbered PI 18.03(1)(b) and amended to read:

17 PI 18.03(1)(b) Earned, in grades 7 to 12, at least 0.5 credit of health education which  
18 incorporates instruction in personal, family, community, and environmental health.

1 SECTION 6. PI 18.05(1)(intro.) is amended to read:


2 PI 18.05(1)(intro.) By ~~July 1, 1988~~ September 1, 1986, each board operating a high  
3 school shall submit to the state superintendent, on forms provided by the department, a  
4 report describing the board's high school graduation policies governing diplomas which  
5 shall be granted subsequent to September 1, 1988. Such policies shall include:

6 SECTION 7. Following PI 18.05(1)(d) a note is added to read:

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the
