ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RENUMERING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 27.03(3)(b) 2; and renumbering s. NR 27.03(3)(b) 3. to 6. of Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to deleting the double-crested cormorant from the Wisconsin threatened species list.

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The Wisconsin endangered species law (s. 29.415, Stats.) requires periodic updating of DNR's endangered and threatened species list. The DNR bureau of endangered resources has reviewed the population status of the double-crested cormorant and determined that it should be deleted from the Wisconsin threatened species list.

The determination to delete the double-crested cormorant was based on the species' statewide recovery over the past 12 years. Annual investigations by DNR wildlife managers, endangered resources biologists, and other wildlife experts documented the recovery.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the state of Wisconsin natural resources board by ss. 29.415 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats., the state of Wisconsin natural resources board hereby repeals and renumbers rules interpreting s. 29.415, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 27.03(3)(b)2. is repealed.

SECTION 2. NR 27.03(3)(b)3. to 6. are renumbered NR 27.03(3)(b) 2. to 5.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the state of Wisconsin natural resources board on May 29, 1986.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
