ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreat- . A-39-85
ing Table 1 in section NR 485.04(1) .

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

This rule change revises the emission limitations which must be met by motor vehicles which are required to be inspected under the emission inspection and maintenance program established under section 110.20, Wis. Stats., and operating in six counties in southeastern Wisconsin (Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Washington and Waukesha). The emission limitations, which the department is required to adopt and revise under section 144.42(2); Wis. Stats., are expressed in terms of maximum concentrations of carbon monoxide and hydrocarbons in the exhaust. The emission limitations are applicable to all motor vehicles which are registered in the six counties unless the motor vehicles are exempt from the emission limitations. (The exempt motor vehicles are specified in section 144.42(5), Wis. Stats., and section NR 485.04(2), Wis. Adm. Code.) The emission limits are currently in s. NR 154.17(3)(a), Wis. Adm. Code, which is being renumbered to s. NR 485.04(1), Wis. Adm. Code, in another rule package.

The proposed changes to the rule are:

1. A reduction in allowable tailpipe emissions for some model year groups of automobiles and light trucks inspected within the program. This action is necessary to achieve and maintain the regional emission reductions specified in the department's state implementation plan for attaining ozone and carbon monoxide air quality standards.
2. A reallocation of model year groupings which will enable the emission limitations to more equitably reflect the impacts of vehicle age and wear.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by ss. 144.31(1)(a), 144.42(2), and 227.014(2)(a), Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals and recreates rules interpreting s. 144.42(2), Stats., and revising the State Implementation Plan developed under s. 144.31(1)(f), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Table 1 in NR 485.04(1) is repealed and recreated to read:




