Analysis prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

General summary of rule. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation adopts this rule change solely to bring the language of this rule into conformity with the current statute which has been changed by the adoption of 1983 Wis Act 70 which repealed s. 346.503(5), Wis. Stats., giving the Department the authority to enforce compliance with designating parking spaces for the handicapped.

Final Regulatory Flexibility Analysis. This rule change will not have an effect upon any small businesses.

Fiscal effect. This rule change will not have a fiscal effect upon the state, any local governments or the private sector.


