ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING
AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF renumbering s. NR 11.041(2); amending :
ss. NR 10.01(3)(e)9.e., 10.01(4)(e)2.(intro.), and :
10.28, repealing and recreating s. NR 10.01(3)(e)(intro) : WM-11-86
and 1. to 6., and creating ss. NR 10.06(6)(jm) and :
11.042 pertaining to hunting and trapping regulations. :

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rules are promulgated under the authority of ss. 23.09(2)(intro.), 29.174(3), 227.014(2)(a), and 227.02(1)(e), Stats., and interpret ss. 29.085, 29.108 and 29.174(1), Stats.

Six rule proposals are presented relating to hunting and trapping of certain game species in Wisconsin.

1. Deer management unit boundaries - The boundaries of 38 deer management units are modified to reflect areas containing similar land use, soils and vegetative cover.

2. Overwinter deer population goals - Biological and social considerations have modified the overwinter deer population goal in 30 deer management units.

3. Deer gun season framework - A statewide gun deer season is established as follows: Zone A - 9-day buck and hunter's choice permit (includes most of state). Zone B - 2-day either sex followed by 7-day buck only (5 deer management units adjacent to the Mississippi River).

4. Firearm option - Allow rifles, shotguns, muzzle-loaders and handguns for deer hunting in deer management unit 22A.

5. Deer management unit uniformity - Create a 9-day buck and hunter's choice permit season for all of deer management unit 60A.

6. Pheasant hunting closure - Establish a 2:00 p.m. pheasant hunting closure for Muddy Creek Wildlife Area, Dunn County.

7. Closed area modification - Allow bow deer hunting on the Oakridge Lake closed area, St. Croix County.

In the counties or parts of counties and deer management units of Buffalo (unit 59B portion), Brown, Calumet, Chippewa (unit 59B portion), Dane, Dodge, Door (Detroit, Plum, Rock, and Washington Islands only), Dunn (unit 59B portion), Green, Jefferson, Kenosha, Kewaunee, Lafayette, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Ozaukee, Pepin (unit 59B portion), Pierce (unit 59B, 60 and 60A portions), Racine, Rock, St. Croix (unit 59B and 60 portions), Sheboygan, Shawano (south of highway 29), Walworth, Washington, Waukesha, Waupaca, and Winnebago.	Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 9 consecutive days.	One buck deer per season or hunter's choice permit limit.
b. Deer management unit 79 except Long island	Muzzle-loading firearm season October 1-31.	One deer per season, either sex.
c. Deer management unit 82	Firearm season beginning on the Saturday preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 9 consecutive days.	One buck deer with an unforked antler or hunter's choice permit limit.
d. All other parts of Zone "A".	Firearm season beginning on the Saturday preceding the Thanksgiving	One buck per season or hunter's choice permit limit.

2. Zone "B"

Deer management units 59D, 61, 61B, 61C, 74A and 74B.

- a. The Buffalo, La Crosse and Trempealeau portions of deer management unit 61, the La Crosse county portion of unit 74A and the Jackson, La Crosse and Monroe county portions of unit 59D.

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days. One deer per season, either sex.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days. One buck deer per season.

- b. The Pepin and Pierce county portion of deer management unit 61.

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days. One deer per season, either sex.

Shotgun season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days. One buck deer per season.

- c. Deer management unit 61B (Trempealeau national wildlife refuge)

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days. One deer per hunter's choice permit per season.

- d. Deer management unit 61C except during closed periods established by s. NR 11.031(2)(b)

Shotgun season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding

the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the shotgun season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days. One buck deer per season or hunter's choice permit limit.

- e. Deer management unit 74B and the Vernon county portion of deer management units 59D and 74A

Firearm season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 2 consecutive days. One deer per season, either sex.

Firearm season beginning on the day immediately after the firearm season described above and continuing for 7 consecutive days. One buck deer per season.

- 3. Zone "C"
Governor Dodge (unit 70C), Blue Mound (unit 70D), and Perrot (unit 61A) state parks except areas posted closed to hunting.

Muzzle-loading firearm season beginning on the Saturday immediately preceding the Thanksgiving holiday and continuing for 9 consecutive days. One deer per hunter's choice permit per season.

- 4. Zone "D"
Fort McCoy military reservation in Monroe county and Volk field military facility in Juneau county

Firearm, shotgun, muzzle-loader or handgun season as established by military permit approved by the department by August 1 annually. One deer per season by military permit.

- 5. Zone "E"
Menominee county (unit 48)

Firearm, shotgun, muzzle-loader or handgun as established by the Menominee tribe, for tribal members only. As established by the Menominee tribe.


SECTION 3. NR 10.01(4)(e)2.(intro.) is amended to read:

SECTION 7. NR 11.042 is created to read:

NR 11.042 DUCK CLOSED AREA; TRAPPING AND DEER HUNTING PERMITTED. A closed season is established in the following areas posted with department signs. Trapping of furbearing mammals is permitted during established seasons. No person may hunt any species of wild animal, except deer during periods established in s. NR 10.01(3)(e) and (em), during the open season on ducks established in s. NR 10.01(1)(b). Legally killed or crippled game may be retrieved by dog or hand.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the Natural Resources Board on June 26, 1986.




