RL 4.01 Authorization. The following rules are adopted by the depart-

ment of regulation and licensing pursuant to s. 440.06. Stats.

- $RL\ 4.02$ Definitions. (1) "Department" means the department of regulation and licensing.
- (2) "Board" means the board of nursing and any examining board attached to the department.
- (3) "Applicant" means a person who applies for a license, permit, certificate or registration granted by the department or a board.
- (4) "Examination" means the written and practical tests required of an applicant by the department or a board.

- RL 4.03 Refunds. (1) Applicants who are found to be unqualified for examination by the department or by a board will receive a full refund.
- (2) An applicant who fails to take an examination shall receive a refund of all but \$20 of the examination fee if:
- (a) The applicant provides written notice at least 10 days in advance that the applicant is unable to take the examination or
- (b) The applicant who fails to provide written notice submits a written explanation satisfactory to the board or department that the applicant's failure to take the examination resulted from extreme personal hardship.
- (c) An applicant eligible for a refund may forfeit the refund and choose instead to take an examination administered within 18 months of the originally scheduled examination at no added charge.
- (3) Applicants who pay the fees specified in s. 440.05 (2), (3), (6) and (8), Stats., will receive a full refund if the license, permit, certificate, registration is not granted or if the application is withdrawn.

- RL 4.04 Examination fees. (1) The minimum examination fee is \$40. The fee for a complete examination or examination parts for an original license, permit, certificate or registration is shown in column 3 of figure 4.04 (3). The total initial fee is the sum of the initial fees for the parts required, but no less than \$40.
- (2) The minimum reexamination fee is \$20. The fee for retaking less than a complete examination or for retaking a one-part examination is shown in column 4 of figure 4.04 (3).

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(3) The fees for examinations and reexaminations required by the department are as follows: (See figure 4.04 (3).)
