Pursuant to the authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board in ss. 15.08(5)(b), 227.11(2)(a), and 453.07, Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board, interpreting s. 453.07, <u>Stats.</u>, hereby repeals and recreates s. VE 3.02 (intro.) and creates s. VE 3.02(28) relating to a definition of unprofessional conduct as follows:

SECTION 1. VE 3.02 (intro.) is repealed and recreated to read:

VE 3.02 (intro.) The following acts constitute unprofessional conduct by a veterinarian and are prohibited. Unprofessional conduct includes but is not limited to:

SECTION 2. VE 3.02(28) is created to read:

VE 3.02(28) Conduct in the practice of veterinary medicine which evidences a lack of knowledge or ability to apply professional principles or skills.

The rules created and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month commencing after the date of publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, pursuant to s. 227.22(2), Stats.
