ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
CREATING RULES

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rules are promulgated under the authority of ss. 29.155(1), 29.174(3), 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats., and interpret ss. 29.155(1) and 29.174(1), Stats.

The proposed rules provide for a free fishing day each year for sport anglers fishing the inland and outlying waters of the state.

SECTION 1. NR 20.0125 is created to read:

NR 20.0125 LICENSE WAIVER. (1) On the third Saturday of June each year, no fishing license is required to fish the inland or outlying waters.

(2) The license waiver of sub. (1) does not apply to commercial fishing license requirements.

SECTION 2. NR 21.015 is created to read:

NR 21.015 LICENSE WAIVER. (1) On the third Saturday of June each year, no fishing license is required to fish the Wisconsin-Minnesota boundary waters.

(2) The license waiver of sub. (1) does not apply to commercial fishing license requirements.

SECTION 3. NR 22.015 is created to read:

NR 22.015 LICENSE WAIVER. (1) On the third Saturday in June each year, no fishing license is required to fish the Wisconsin-Iowa boundary waters.

(2) The license waiver of sub. (1) does not apply to commercial fishing license requirements.

SECTION 4. NR 23.015 is created to read:

NR 23.015 LICENSE WAIVER. On the third Saturday in June each year, no fishing license is required to fish the Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 20, 1986.

The rules shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


