

ORDER

Text of Rule

Pursuant to authority vested in the medical examining board by sections 15.08(5)(b), 227.11(2)(a) and 448.05, Stats., the medical examining board hereby repeals and recreates section Med 1.06(title) and Med 1.06(1), interpreting section 448.05, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. Med 1.06(title) and Med 1.06(1) are repealed and recreated to read:

Med 1.06 PANEL REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS; EXAMINATIONS REQUIRED. (1) Panel Review; Oral and Written Examinations. (a) All applicants shall complete a written examination. In addition, an applicant shall complete an oral examination if the applicant:

1. Has a history of alcohol or drug abuse or impairment;
2. Has a history of psychological impairment;
3. Has been disciplined or had licensure denied by a licensing or regulatory authority in Wisconsin or another jurisdiction;
4. Has been found to have been negligent in the practice of medicine or has been a party in a lawsuit in which it was alleged that the applicant had been negligent in the practice of medicine;
5. Has been convicted of a crime the circumstances of which substantially related to the practice of medicine;
6. Has lost, had reduced or had suspended his or her hospital staff privileges, or has failed to continuously maintain hospital privileges during the applicant's period of licensure following post-graduate training; or,
7. Has been graduated from a medical school not approved by the board.

(b) An application filed under s. Med 1.02 shall be reviewed by an application review panel of at least two board members designated by the chairperson of the board. The panel shall determine whether the applicant is eligible for a regular license without completing an oral examination.

(c) All examinations shall be conducted in the English language.

(d) Where both written and oral examinations are required they shall be scored separately and the applicant shall achieve a passing grade on both examinations to qualify for a license.

The rule created and adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, pursuant to s. 227.22, Stats.
