ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

.....  
IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating :  
s. NR 20.04(3)(d), Wis. Adm. Code, pertaining : FM-50-86  
to snagging on Lake Michigan, Green Bay and :  
tributary streams :

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rule is promulgated under the authority of ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats., and interprets ss. 29.085 and 29.174(1) and (2), Stats.

The proposed rule eliminates the snagging season for trout and salmon in Lake Michigan, Green Bay and tributary streams.

SECTION 1. NR 20.04(3)(d) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 20.04(3)(d) During the period of October 1 to but not including the first Saturday in May of the following May, annually, upstream to the first dam or lake on any stream tributary to Lake Michigan or Green Bay, except the Kewaunee river where this paragraph applies upstream to the third county hwy. "C" bridge, hook and line fishing is restricted to baits using a hook with a maximum gape size of one-half inch from point to shank. During this period, fishing with hook and line is prohibited between one-half hour after sunset and one-half hour before sunrise on all streams tributary to Lake Michigan and Green Bay except the Menominee river, Oconto river and its tributaries and the Fox river.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 26, 1987.

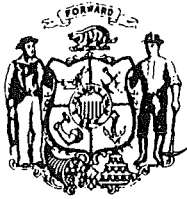
The rules shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


