Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

The rules are promulgated under the authority of ss. 23.09(2), 23.11(1) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats., and interpret s. 23.11(1), Stats.

The proposed rule will add the New Fane trail parking area and Highway H snowmobile and horse trail parking area in the northern unit Kettle Moraine state forest and the Lapham Peak unit of the Kettle Moraine state forest to the vehicle admission sticker requirement.

SECTION 1. NR 45.12(1)(b)5.m. and n. and 6m. are created to read:

- NR 45.12(1)(b)5.m. New Fane trail parking area.
- n. Highway H snowmobile and horse trail parking area.
- 6m. Kettle Moraine state forest - Lapham Peak unit.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 26, 1987.

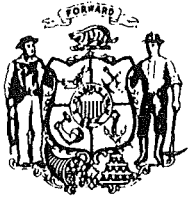


