



ORDER OF THE  
PHARMACY INTERNSHIP BOARD  
ADOPTING RULES

Relating to: Registration for Pharmacy Internship

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Analysis Prepared by State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Internship Board

Prior to taking the examination for registry as a pharmacist, a person must complete an internship in Wisconsin or the equivalent of the internship in another state. In Wisconsin, the internship board is responsible for registering interns. Currently, internship credit may also be granted to students in professional experience programs sponsored by a Bachelor of Science or Doctor of Pharmacy degree granting institution, but the student is not required to register as an intern. This provision requires such students to register as pharmacy interns. The registration fee is \$10.

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Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin pharmacy internship board by s. 36.25(20), Stats., the State of Wisconsin pharmacy internship board hereby adopts rules interpreting ss. 36.25(20) and 450.045(1), Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. PH-INT 1.02(2) is amended to read:

PH-INT 1.02(2). Registration as an intern is required of all individuals practicing as an intern regardless of credit or non-credit status; ~~except--these-students--enrolled-as-part--of-a-professional--experience--program--sponsored-by--a--professional Bachelor-of-Science-degree-or-Doctor-of-pharmacy-degree-granting institution;~~

SECTION 2. PH-INT 1.04(3) is amended to read:

PH-INT 1.04(3). All "Internship-for-Credit" shall be under the supervision of a preceptor who is certified by the pharmacy internship board except for internship served as part of a professional experience program sponsored by a professional Bachelor of Science or Doctor of pharmacy degree granting institution;

The rules, amendments, and repeals contained in this order shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2) (intro.), Stats.
