ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 19.09(3) . of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to the posting notice for opening the wild rice season .

Authorizing statutes: ss. 29.544 and 227.11(2)(a) and (d), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.544(2)(a), Stats., as proposed to be amended by 1987

Senate Bill 102

The rule will reduce the notice requirement for the opening of the wild rice season on any given lake or stream from 48 to 24 hours.

SECTION 1. NR 19.09(3) is amended to read:

NR 19.09(3) The secretary is authorized and directed, after determining by investigation and study that the wild rice is ripe, to designate the open season for harvesting or gathering wild rice in each of the hereinafter-following-described areas described in sub. (4). Such The open season in any such area to may begin not no earlier than August 15 and to may continue in effect for not more than 60 days. Such The open season in any such area as designated by the secretary pursuant to this subsection shall be put into effect by posting of proper notice of such the open season on the shores of, and at places of public access to, the lakes and streams in which such the open season is effective at least 48 24 hours before the beginning of such the open season.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 28, 1987.

The rule contained herein shall take effect the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
