ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT IN THE MATTER OF RULEMAKING :

PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE OF REGULATION AND DEPARTMENT OF REGULATION : LICENSING ADOPTING RULES

AND LICENSING

#### ORDER

The Department of Regulation and Licensing adopts an order to amend RL 4.04(3) and 4.04, relating to examination and refund fees.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

#### ANALYSIS

In this order, the department of regulation and licensing amends s. RL 4.04(3) to revise refund rules for applicants who pay fees to test providers other than the department.

Under s. RL 4.04, the department revises fees for examination or reexamination of animal technicians, pharmacists, and veterinarians. It eliminates from the examination fee schedule examinations for accountants, architects, and real estate brokers and salespersons, and clarifies that fees for examinations not listed are established by the test provider.

### TEXT OF THE RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the department of regulation and licensing in ss. 227.11(2)(a) and 440.06, Stats., and s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, the department of regulation and licensing hereby amends rules interpreting s. 440.05(1), as affected by 1985 Wisconsin Act 29, and s. 440.06, Stats., as follows:

SECTION 1. RL 4.03(1) and (2)(intro.) are amended to read:

RL 4.03 Refunds. (1) Applicants who are found to be unqualified for an examination administered by the department or by a board will shall receive a full refund.

(2) An applicant who fails to take an examination administered by the department shall receive a refund of all but \$20 of the examination fee if:

SECTION 2. RL 4.03(3) is renumbered RL 4.03(4).

SECTION 3. RL 4.03(2)(c) is renumbered RL 4.03(3).

SECTION 4. RL 4.03(5) is created to read:

(4) Applicants who pay fees to test providers other than the department are subject to the refund policy established by the test provider.

#### SECTION 5. RL 4.04 is amended to read:

- RL 4.04 Examination fees. (1) The minimum examination fee for examinations administered by the department is \$40. The fee for a complete examination or examination parts for an original license, permit, certificate or registration is shown in column 3 of figure 4.04(3). The total initial fee is the sum of the initial fees for the parts required, but no less than \$40. For examinations not listed in figure 4.04(3), the fee is established by the test provider.
- (2) The minimum reexamination fee for examinations administered by the department is \$20. The fee for retaking less than a complete examination or for retaking a one-part examination is shown in column 4 of figure 4.04(3). For examinations not listed in figure 4.04(3), the fee is established by the test provider.
- (3) The fees for examinations and reexaminations required administered by the department are as follows: (See figure 4.04(3).)
