Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

The rules are promulgated under the authority of ss. 144.31, 144.38 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats., and interpret s. 144.31(1)(f), Stats., and the State Implementation Plan (SIP) developed under that provision.

The Department of Natural Resources adopted rules which established air emission limitations for certain sources of sulfur dioxide in Peshtigo in 1984 as s. NR 154.12(8). Changes to some of the emission limits in this rule are necessary because the pulp mill regulated by the rule has developed a final control strategy and has modified control equipment such that the existing rule is not applicable in four areas. Also the revision is necessary for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to approve Wisconsin's State Implementation Plan for Peshtigo.

SECTION 1. NR 418.06(1)(a)(intro.) and 1. are renumbered NR 418.06(1)(a) and, as renumbered, are amended to read:

NR 418.06(1)(a) From any liquid fossil fuel and natural gas fired steam generating boiler, 0.626 with the emission point at a height above ground of less than 55 feet, 0.520 pounds per million BTU heat input if-any-liquid fossil-fuel-and-natural-gas-fired-steam-generating-boiler-at-the-mill-emits from-a-point-54-feet-above-ground,-or.

SECTION 2. NR 418.06(1)(a)2. and 3. are repealed.

SECTION 3. NR 418.06(1)(b)(intro.) and 1. are renumbered NR 418.06(1)(b) and, as renumbered, are amended to read:

NR 418.06(1)(b) From any liquid fossil fuel, natural gas and wood refuse fired steam generating boiler, 0.626 with the emission point at a height above ground of more than 149 feet, 0.520 pounds per million BTU heat input if-any-liquid-fossil-fuel-and-natural-gas-fired-steam-generating-boiler-at-the mill-emits-from-a-point-54-feet-above-ground,-or.

SECTION 4. NR 418.06(1)(b)2. and 3. are repealed.

SECTION 5. NR 418.06(1)(f) and (g) are amended to read:

NR 418.06(1)(f) From any acid-plant-emitting-from-a-point-99-feet-or-moreabove-ground,-0.543-pounds-per-hour evaporator building emitting from a point 87 feet or more above ground, 6.10 pounds per hour.

(g) From all other sources, a total of 6-82 0.72 pounds per hour.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on July 23, 1987

The rules shall take effect as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
