ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING AND RECREATING, AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating

s. NR 46.30(2)(a) to (d) and creating s. NR 46.16(7); of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to administration of the Forest Crop Law and Managed Forest Law.

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: 77.91(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: 77.06(2) and 77.80 to 77.91(1), Stats.

Section NR 46.16(7), is proposed to clarify that an owner, on a petition to designate land as managed forest land, has the option to request a new and separate order of designation or amend an existing order of designation if the petitioned land is contiguous to existing managed forest land. An amended order would result in the petitioned land being added to an existing managed forest land order.

For purposes of the forest crop law and managed forest law, this rule repeals and recreates s. NR 46.30(2) to revise annual stumpage values used to calculate severance and yield tax due on timber cut from lands entered as forest cropland or designated as managed forest land as of November 1, 1987, as required by ss. 77.06(2) and 77.91(1), Stats. Twelve separate zones reflect varying stumpage prices for different species and products across the state. This zoning results in severance and yield taxes which more nearly represent 10% and 5% of the actual stumpage value.

SECTION 1. NR 46.16(7) is created to read:

NR 46.16(7) ADDITIONS. An owner petitioning the department to designate 10 or more acres of land as managed forest land which is contiguous to designated managed forest land shall indicate on the petition whether the land subject to the petition is to be ordered designated as managed forest land under a separate order or as an addition to the previously designated and contiguous managed forest land.

SECTION 2. NR 46.30(2)(a) to (d) is repealed and recreated to read: NR 46.30(2)(a) Logs (stumpage value per M board feet measure).


