## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES AMENDING RULES

To amend HSS 55.58(4)(b), relating to day care for children.

### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services

This rule change extends the period of certification from one year to two years for persons who provide day care for 1 to 3 children or who provide day care for school age children but are not required to be licensed as a day care center under s. 48.65, Stats., and whose services are purchased by county social service departments with state community aid funds.

Making the period of certification 2 years instead of one year will significantly reduce the paperwork, staff time and related costs incurred by both county agencies responsible for issuing certifications and day care providers applying for certification and going through the certification process.

The Department's authority to adopt these rules is found in s. 46.03(21), Stats. The rules interpret s. 48.651, Stats.

SECTION 1. HSS 55.58(4)(b) is amended to read:

HSS 55.58(4)(b) <u>Regular certification</u>. Regular certification may be issued only after the provider has demonstrated compliance with all certification standards during the 6-month provisional certification. Regular certification shall be for a period of one year 2 years and shall be renewed annually upon application and if the provider continues to comply with the certification standards; or

The rules contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.22(2), Stats.
