# ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING RENUMBERING AND AMENDING AMENDING AND REPEAL

REPEALING, RENUMBERING AND AMENDING, AMENDING, AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 25.03(2)(b)2.

(intro.) and a. and (c) to (e); renumbering and amending s. NR 25.03(2)(b)2.b.; amending ss.

NR 25.03(2)(a) and (b)(intro.) and 1.,

25.04(7)(intro.),25.055(intro.), 25.06(2)(c)3. and

25.09(2)(d)2.c.; and repealing and recreating

s. NR 25.03(2)(b)3. of the Wisconsin Administrative

Code pertaining to commercial fishing in Green Bay and Lake Michigan

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#### Analysis Prépared by Department of Natural Resources

Authorizing statutes: ss. 29.174(3), 29.33(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.174(2)(a) and 29.33(1), Stats.

By repealing "sunset" clauses, the order indefinitely extends rules that limit Great Lakes commercial fishing license availability, limit license transfers and require experienced fishers present as supervisors during fishing operations. Existing rules that establish forage base harvest quotas and limit commercial trawling to specific areas in Lake Michigan 60 feet or deeper have their "sunset" dates extended by three years to May 1, 1991.

The Order also deletes provisions of the code that listed priorities according to which licenses were issued to various classes of applicants. These provisions are no longer needed because there is now only one class of applicants who may receive a license -- individuals who held a license the previous year.

SECTION 1. NR 25.03(2)(a) and (b)(intro.) and 1. are amended to read:

NR 25.03(2) LAKE MICHIGAN. (a)

Except-as-provided-in-par.-(d),-the <u>The</u> number of licenses authorizing commercial fishing in Lake Michigan issued for any license year shall be limited to the maximum number issued for either-of-the-immediately-preceding-2-license-years <u>the previous</u> year. This section does not apply to licenses for

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fishing only for the harvest of rough fish from outlying waters under a permit or contract issued under s. 29.62 or 29.625, Stats.

- (b)(intro.) Except-as-provided-in-par.-(c),-applications

  Applications for licenses authorizing commercial fishing in Lake

  Michigan which have been filed in accordance with sub. (3) shall be reviewed and approved or denied pursuant to the following criteria:
- 1. For-the-first-year-of-eligibility-the The applicant shall show proof of a \$5,000 investment in commercial fishing equipment not to include vehicles other than those directly employed in operating nets.
- SECTION 2. NR 25.03(2)(b)2.(intro.) and a. are repealed.
- SECTION 3. NR 25.03(2)(b)2.b. is renumbered NR 25.03(2)(b) 2. and amended to read:

NR 25.03(2)(b)2. At To retain eligibility for the second year and thereafter, the applicant shall show proof of at least 30 days lifting nets on Lake Michigan during the previous license year unless unavoidable circumstances prevented the applicant from lifting nets. These circumstances shall be reviewed by the Lake Michigan commercial fishing board which shall in these cases recommend approval or denial of the license.

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SECTION 4. NR 25.03(2)(b)3. is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 25.03(2)(b)3. The applicant held a Lake Michigan commercial fishing license throughout the previous license year or received a license by transfer under s. NR 25.04.

SECTION 5. NR 25.03(2)(c) to (e) are repealed.

SECTION 6. NR 25.04(7)(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 25.04(7) Notwithstanding subs. (1) to (6), a licensed commercial fisher may not transfer a license authorizing commercial fishing on Green Bay or Lake Michigan to another person during-the-1986-1987-and-1987-1988-license-year unless:

SECTION 7. NR 25.055(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 25.055 SUPERVISOR PRESENCE REQUIRED.

During-the-1986-1987-and-1987-1988-license-years-no No person may:

SECTION 8. NR 25.06(2)(c)3. is amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(c)3. This paragraph shall be in effect until May 1, 1988 1991.

SECTION 9. NR 25.09(2)(d)2.c. is amended to read:

NR 25.09(2)(d)2.c. This subdivision shall be in effect until May 1, 1988 1991.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 28, 1988.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
