Analysis Prepared by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation

General Summary of Proposed Rule. Chapter Trans 326 adopted motor carrier safety requirements for transportation of hazardous materials of the United States department of transportation in effect on October 1, 1987. This proposed amendment changes the date from October 1, 1984 to October 1, 1987. This change allows Wisconsin to enforce the most recent version of the motor carrier safety requirements for transportation of hazardous materials. All vehicles operating in interstate commerce are already subject under federal law, to any changes that have been adopted between October 1, 1984 and October 1, 1987.

Fiscal estimate. This rule change will not have a fiscal effect upon the state, any local governments or the private sector.

Regulatory of flexibility analysis. This rule change will not have an effect upon any small businesses.

Rule Text

SECTION 1. TRANS 326.01 is amended to read:

Trans 326.01 FEDERAL RULES ADOPTED. The following federal regulations adopted by the United States department of transportation and in effect on March-28,-1985 October 1, 1987, are adopted by the department and shall be enforced in relation to those carriers, drivers or vehicles to which these federal

rules apply in the same manner as though the regulations were set out in full in this section:

- (1) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 107, Hazardous Materials Program Procedures;
- (2) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 171, Hazardous Materials Regulations;
- (3) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 172, Hazardous Materials Tables and Hazardous Materials Communications Regulations;
- (4) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 173, General Requirements for Shipments and Packagings;
- (5) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 177, Carriage by Public Highway;
- (6) Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, part 178, Shipping Container Specifications.
