REPEALING, RENUMBERING AND CREATING RULES

This rule combines chs. NR 207, 217 and 220 into one chapter numbered NR 220.

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SECTION 1. Chapter NR 207 (title) is renumbered NR 220, subchapter II (title).

SECTION 2. NR 207.01 to 207.06 are renumbered NR 220.10 to 220.15, respectively.

SECTION 3. NR 207.07 is repealed.

SECTION 4. Chapter NR 217 (title) is renumbered NR 220, subchapter III (title).

SECTION 5. NR 217.01 and 217.10 are renumbered NR 220.20 and 220.21, respectively.

SECTION 6. Chapter NR 220 (title) is renumbered NR 220, subchapter I (title).

SECTION 7. Chapter NR 220 (title) is created to read:

CATEGORIES AND CLASSES OF POINT SOURCES AND EFFLUENT LIMITATIONS

SECTION 8. TERMINOLOGY CHANGES. Wherever the term "chapter" appears in the following sections of the code, the term "subchapter" is substituted: NR 220.01, 220.10, 220.11, 220.12, 220.20 and 220.21, all as renumbered.

SECTION 9. CROSS-REFERENCE CHANGES. In the sections of the code listed in Column A, the cross-references shown in Column B are changed to the cross-references shown in Column C:
