## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES REPEALING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

To repeal HSS 139.08(3); to amend HSS 139.06(1), 139.08(1), (2) and (5) and 139.09(1), (2) and (3); and to create HSS 139.09(4), relating to the qualifications of public health professionals serving as health officers for the purpose of communicable disease control, public health nurses and directors of public health nursing programs.

## Analysis Prepared by the Department of Health and Social Services

The Department's rules on qualifications of public health professionals serving as health officers for the purpose of communicable disease control, public health nurses and directors of local public health nursing programs, ss. HSS 139.06, 139.08 and 139.09, went into effect on December 1, 1984. These rules give individuals who were employed as public health professionals serving as health officers for the purpose of communicable disease control, public health nurses and directors of local public health nursing programs on the effective date of the rules until December 1, 1989, to meet the qualifications. Since the rules have been in effect, the Department has learned that some persons covered by ss. HSS 139.06, 139.08 and 139.09 cannot obtain the required education without a great deal of expense or travel.

This order modifies the optional requirement that a person employed as director of a local public health nursing program on December 1, 1984, meet the education and experience requirements in s. HSS 139.09 by extending the compliance deadline to December 1, 1991. Further, the order permits an individual to continue to serve as director of a public health nursing program if that person was employed in that capacity on April 1, 1988 and was the recipient of a public health nurse certificate issued by the Department prior to December 1, 1984. All directors of local public health nursing programs hired after April 1, 1988, must meet the education and experience requirements in s. HSS 139.09.

This order also amends provisions of ss. HSS 139.06 and 139.08 which require public health professionals serving as health officers for the purpose of communicable disease control and public health nurses to have a degree from a nursing program accredited by the national professional nursing education accrediting organization or a degree from a nonaccredited nursing program but preparation in public health nursing in a program accredited by the national professional nursing education accrediting organization. Because there are no longer separately accredited programs in public health nursing preparation, the option of a degree from a nonaccredited program with preparation in public health nursing is deleted. The requirement of a degree from an accredited program is changed so that accreditation by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is acceptable as an alternative to accreditation by the national professional nursing education accrediting organization. This change is made because in some parts of the state there are no nursing programs accredited by the national organization.

Finally, the order extends by two years, to December 1, 1991, the deadline by which public health nurses must meet the requirements in s. HSS 139.08. This change is made in response to the uncertainty that has surrounded the rule since its promulgation in 1984.

The Department's authority to repeal, amend and create these rules is found in ss. 140.05(3), 141.01(3)(a) and 141.045(1), Stats. These rules interpret ss. 140.05(1), 141.01(3)(a) and 141.045, Stats.

SECTION 6. HSS 139.09(4) is created to read:

HSS 139.09(4) Employed on April 1, 1988 as the director of a public health nursing program, and a recipient of a public health nurse certificate issued by the department prior to the effective date of this chapter.

The repeal and amendments contained in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register, as provided in s. 227.22(2), Stats.
