

To repeal Chapter WFSB 12, relating to arbitration.

Analysis:

Statutory authority: s. 144.445(4), Stats. Statutes interpreted: s. 144.445(10), Stats.

This rule repeals Chapter WFSB 12, relating to arbitration. Chapter WFSB 12 is repealed in its entirety because it is repetitive of existing statute, conflicts with existing statute, or is confusing.

WFSB 12.01 conflicts with s. 144.445(10)(k), Stats. The rule requires a public meeting that the statute states is optional.

WFSB 12.02 is repetitious of s. 144.445(10)(o), Stats. Both the rule and the statute allow the Board to conduct meetings as necessary with the parties.

WFSB 12.03 is repetitious of s. 144.445(10)(o), Stats. Both the rule and the statute allow the Board to conduct meetings as necessary with the parties.

WFSB 12.04 is confusing because it states that the Board may conduct an optional on-site inspection of a proposed facility after a public informational meeting and after a public hearing. A public informational meeting is optional and a public hearing is never held, so the time for an on-site visit as stated in the rule is without meaning.

WFSB 12.05 is meaningless because it limits the submission of briefs to 14 days after a public hearing although in an arbitration there is no required public hearing.

WFSB 12.06 is repetitious of s. 144.445(10)(p), Stats. Both the rule and the statute require that the Board must render an arbitration award in 90 days.

SECTION 1. Chapter WFSB 12 is repealed.

Initial Regulatory Flexibility Analysis:

This rule does not affect small businesses.

Fiscal Estimate:

The proposed rule has no fiscal effect.

Effective Date:

The adoption of this rule takes effect on the first day of the month following its publication in the Wisconsin administrative register under s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
