

ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

AMENDING A RULE

To renumber s. Ins 6.06 (5) (a) (1) 1 to 4, and (2); to renumber and amend s. Ins 6.06 (5) (a) (1) (intro.); and to amend s. Ins 6.06 (9), and 6.06, Appendix I, relating to the certificate of compliance that must be filed with the Commissioner when an insurer files a rate with the Commissioner.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Statutory Authority: ss. 601.41 (3), 601.42 (1), 625.02 (3), and 625.11, Stats.

Statutes Interpreted: s. 625.13, Stats.

The purpose of this rule is to revise wording in the certificate of compliance that insurers file with the Commissioner along with their rate filings. The certificate certifies that the rate filing, to the best of the information, knowledge, and belief of the person signing the certificate, complies with Wisconsin insurance laws. The current certificate, however, contains language implying that the certificate is a form filing. This has created confusion since the Commissioner requires insurers to file a separate and distinct certificate of compliance when filing policy forms with the Office. To clarify that the certificate of compliance filed with rate filings is not connected to the certificate of compliance filed with policy forms, this rule deletes reference to "form" and clarifies that the filing is a rate filing.

SECTION 1. Ins 6.06 (5) (a) (1) 1 to 4 and (2) are renumbered Ins 6.06 (5) (a) 1 a to d and 2, and Ins 6.06 (5) (a) 1 (intro.), as renumbered, is amended to read:

Ins (5) (a) 1. (intro.) At least three separate and consecutive years of both Wisconsin and aggregate of all state's experience showing:

SECTION 2. Ins 6.06 (9) is amended to read:

Ins 6.06 (9) The filings required pursuant to ~~sub.-(2)~~ s. 625.13 (1), Stats., shall be accompanied by a certificate of compliance in a form substantially similar to that set forth in Appendix I.

SECTION 3. Ins 6.06, Appendix I, is amended to read:


