

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF
THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM
AMENDING RULES

[INTRODUCTORY CLAUSE]

The Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System adopts an order to amend UWS 6.02, relating to faculty grievances.

[PLAIN LANGUAGE ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE UW SYSTEM]

Under s. 36.13(3), Wisconsin Statutes, the Board of Regents of the University of Wisconsin System ("board") is required to promulgate rules governing a variety of faculty personnel matters. The order revises the Board's existing rule concerning faculty grievances, section UWS 6.02. Under the existing language of the rule, the board is permitted to receive and act upon a faculty grievance only when a faculty committee reviewing the grievance recommends solutions to the board. Under the order, the requirement of the rule that the board review a faculty grievance only when it receives recommendations from a faculty committee is deleted. In its place, the order provides that the rule be amended to permit the board the option of considering a faculty grievance on the record upon the petition of the faculty grievant as well as upon receipt of recommendations from a faculty committee.

[TEXT OF RULE]

Section UWS 6.02 is amended to read:

UWS 6.02 GRIEVANCES. The faculty of each institution shall designate a committee or other appropriate faculty body to hear faculty grievances under rules and procedures established by the faculty of the institution in conjunction with the chancellor/~~such~~. The committee or faculty body shall have the power to conduct hearings and fact-finding related to the grievance/~~and the authority~~ to recommend solutions to ~~such/grievances~~ the grievance to the chancellor/~~and to the Board~~/~~should the matter not be resolved at the institutional level~~. If the committee or other body makes recommendations to the chancellor, the chancellor shall act on the recommendations within 30 days. The decision by the chancellor on the recommendation of the committee, or on the grievance in the absence of committee recommendation, shall be final except that the board, upon petition of a grievant or the committee or other faculty body, may grant a review on the record.

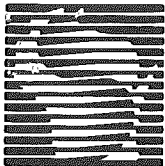
This rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
