ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
CREATING RULES

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

Statutory authority: ss. 29.623, 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 23.09(2), 29.02, 29.05(7), 29.085, 29.47(6), 29.50, 29.535, 29.62(1) and 29.623, Stats.

The rule declares as "detrimental" all species of fish not indigenous to the waters of the state. Under this rule, the department may remove or cause to be removed any such fish from the waters of the state.

SECTION 1. NR 20.15(7) is created to read:

NR 20.15(7) The department of natural resources finds that all fish species, strains or hybrids that are not indigenous to the waters of the state are detrimental fish in all waters of the state except where their presence is specifically permitted under s. 29.535, Stats. The department may remove them or cause them to be removed pursuant to s. 29.623, Stats.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 26, 1989.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


