 northern pike fishing on Wilson Flowage, Price .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

The rule establishes a 32-inch minimum length limit and a daily bag limit of one northern pike on Wilson flowage, Price county.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(d)5. is amended to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
5. <u>Lake Mendota, Dane county and Wilson flowage, Price county</u>	First Saturday in May to March 1	1	32

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on January 26, 1989.

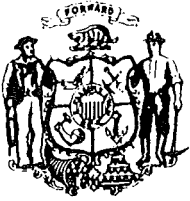
The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


