# ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing s. NR 10.01(4)(e)1.d., renumbering ss. NR 11.03(1) and (2) and 11.031(8); amending ss. NR 10.101(3)(b), 10.106(2)(intro.), 10.125(5)(a)2., 10.13(1)(b)8. and 10., 10.24(4)(f), 11.03(title) and (intro.), 11.031(title) and (intro.), 11.04(title) and (intro.), 11.041(title) and (intro), WM-4-89 11.042(title) and (intro.), 15.04(intro.) and 28.03 (2)(a); repealing and recreating ss. NR 10.106(2)(d), 10.145(1)(c) and 15.022(7)(a); and creating ss. NR 10.104(4)(d)(title), 10.104(2)(d), 11.01(1) and 15.02(2) pertaining to housekeeping modifications to hunting, trapping and miscellaneous regulations.

#### Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: 29.174(3), 29.255, 29.547(6)(a) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: 23.09(2)(b), 23.091 and 29.405, Stats.

- 1. Trapping permits Modify the permit form for bobcat, fisher and otter seasons.
- 2. Dog training Correct NR 10 bear dog training dates consistent with NR 17.
- 3. Deer registration Update rules to accommodate group deer hunting activities.
- 4. Goose hunting Eliminate an unnecessary report card limit.
- 5. Trap placement Require 7" x 7" conibear and toothed traps to be completly submerged in water at all times to restrict harvest of large furbearers to water areas.
- 6. Bong recreation area Change check-in time from 1/2 hour after hunting hours opening to hunting hours opening.
- 7. Closed area/refuges Modify coverage for 10 code sections to improve management capabilities.
- 8. Ginseng Correct season starting date consistent with new legislation.
- 9. Other housekeeping Correct cross-references and create one new title. Allow group applications for muzzle-loader deer hunts in state parks. Allow 3 days for bow deer registration.

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(4)(e)1.d. is repealed.

SECTION 2. NR 10.101(3)(b) is amended to read:

NR 10.101(3)(b) <u>Training</u>. The training of dogs by pursuing wild bear is prohibited except 3uly 1 through August 31.

SECTION 3. NR 10.101(4)(d)(title) and 10.104(2)(d) are created to read:

NR 10.101(4)(d) (title) Exceptions.

NR 10.104(2)(d) Group applications. Group applications up to and including 4 hunters will be honored for deer hunting established in s. NR 10.01(3)(e)3. provided each applicant completes the application form and all forms are submitted in one envelope marked "group application" on the outside.

#### SECTION 4. NR 10.106(2)(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 10.106(2)(intro.) EXHIBITION AND REGISTRATION. Each person who has killed a deer or if s. 29.405, Stats., applies, the person who has tagged the deer, during the open seasons for hunting deer with guns or bear during the open seasons for hunting bear with guns or bows shall exhibit and register the deer with the deer carcass tag attached as required by s. 29.40(1), Stats., and s. NR 10.103, or the bear with the bear carcass tag attached as required by ss. 29.1085(5), Stats., and s. NR 10.101(4) at an authorized registration station as follows:

SECTION 5. NR 10.106(2)(d) is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.106(2)(d) Archer license deer. Archer license deer shall be registered within the county in which the deer was killed unless transported on federal or state highways directly to an authorized registration station outside the county in which the deer was killed by 5:00 P.M. on the third day after the deer was killed.

SECTION 6. NR 10.125(5)(a)2., 10.13(1)(b)8. and 10 are amended to read:

NR 10.125(5)(a)2. Exterior zone permit holders shall be issued 5 report cards. Additional report cards may be issued at select department offices to applicants appearing in person.

Applicants-may-receive-up-to-15-additional-report-cards-for-each-valid Canada-goose-hunting-permit-presented-to-the-department.

NR 10.13(1)(b)8. Killer traps. It-shall-be-unlawful-fer-any No person to may set, place, or operate except-as-a-waterset any killer type trap of the conibear type that is larger than 7" x 7" unless it is located completely underwater at all times.

NR 10.13(1)(b)10. Toothed traps. #t-shall-be-unlawful-fer-any

No person to may set, place or operate any steel jawed trap with

teeth except-as-a-water-set unless it is located completely

underwater at all times.

SECTION 7. NR 10.145(1)(c) is repealed and recreated to read:


NR 10.145(1)(c) The hunter or trapper shall carry a valid
license and the corresponding permit when pursuing a bobcat.

SECTION 8. NR 10.24(4)(f) is amended to read:

NR 10.24(4)(f) <u>Check-in deadline</u>. Any person who obtains a hunting permit reservation and <u>fails-to-arrive arrives</u> at the department's check-in station <u>within-one-half-hour</u> after the opening of hunting hours shall forfeit such reservation. Any person with a waterfowl hunting permit reservation shall report at the department's check-in station no later than one-half hour before the opening of hunting hours or forfeit the reservation. Any person may obtain a daily permit on a first-come, first-served basis provided a permit is available.

SECTION 9. NR 11.01(1) is created to read:

NR 11.01(1) MANITOWOC COUNTY. (a) <u>Collins marsh</u>. Township 19 north, range 21 east, town of Rockland.



SECTION 10. NR 11.03 (title) and (intro.) are amended to read:

NR 11.03 (title) WATERFOWL CLOSED AREA. A closed season is established in the following areas posted with department signs. No person may hunt or trap any species of wild animal thereon during the open season on ducks waterfowl established in s. NR 10.01(1)(b) and (g). Legally killed or crippled game may be retrieved from such areas by dog or hand.

SECTION 11. NR 11.03(1) and (2) are renumbered (2) and (3), respectively.

SECTION 12. NR 11.031(title) and (intro.) is amended to read:

NR 11.031 (title) WATERFOWL CLOSED AREA; TRAPPING PERMITTED. A closed season is established in the following areas posted with department signs. No person may hunt any species of wild animal thereon during the open season on ducks waterfowl established in s.

NR 10.01(1)(b) and (g). Legally killed or crippled game may be retrieved from such areas by dog or hand.

SECTION 13. NR 11.031(8) is renumbered 11.03(1).

SECTION 14. NR 11.04 (title) and (intro.), 11.041(title) and (intro.) and 11.042(title) and (intro.) are amended to read:

NR 11.04 (title) WATERFOWL CLOSED AREA; GUN DEER HUNTING

PERMITTED. A closed season is established in the following areas

posted with department signs. No person may hunt or trap any species

of wild animal thereon, except deer during periods established in s.

NR 10.01 (3)(e), during the open season on ducks waterfowl

established in s. NR 10.01(1)(b) and (g). Legally killed or crippled

game may be retrieved from such areas by dog or hand.


NR 11.041 (title) WATERFOWL CLOSED AREA; TRAPPING AND GUN DEER HUNTING PERMITTED. A closed season is established in the following areas posted with department signs. No person may hunt any species of wild animal thereon, except deer during periods established in s. NR 10.01

(3)(e), during the open season on ducks waterfowl established in s. NR 10.01(1)(b) and (g). Legally killed or crippled game may be retrieved from such areas by dog or hand.

NR 11.042 (title) WATERFOWL CLOSED AREA; TRAPPING, GUN AND BOW DEER HUNTING PERMITTED. A closed season is established in the following areas posted with department signs. Trapping of furbearing mammals is permitted during established seasons. No person may hunt any species of wild animal, except deer during periods established in s. NR 10.01(3)(e) and (em), during the open season on ducks waterfowl established in NR 10.01(1)(b) and (g). Legally killed or crippled game may be retrieved by dog or hand.


SECTION 15. NR 15.02(2) is created to read:

NR 15.02(2) BURNETT COUNTY. (a) <u>Crex Meadows</u>. Township 39 north, range 18 west, town of West Marshland.



SECTION 16. NR 15.022(7)(a) is repealed and recreated to read:

(a) <u>Collins marsh</u>. Township 19 north, range 21 east, town of Rockland.



SECTION 17. NR 15.04 (intro.) is amended to read:

NR 15.04 SEASONAL GAME REFUGE. A game refuge is created in the following areas as posted with department signs and no person may

hunt or trap upon such areas from September 1 through the period waterfowl season established in s. NR 10.01(1); as-open-season-on-waterfowl (b) and (g).

SECTION 18. NR 28.03(2)(a) is amended to read:

NR 28.03(2)(a) <u>Valid period</u>. A harvest license shall be valid for and authorize the taking of wild ginseng during the period beginning <u>August-15 September 1</u> and ending November 1, both dates inclusive.

SECTION 19. <u>CROSS-REFERENCE CHANGES</u>. In the sections of the code listed in Column A, the cross-references shown in Column B are changed to the cross-reference shown in Column C.
