 RENUMBERING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

 IN THE MATTER of renumbering s. NR 20.03(1)(c)4, .
 amending s. NR 20.03(1)(c)3, and creating s. NR .
 20.03(1)(c)4, Wisconsin Administrative Code, . FM-6-89
 pertaining to walleye and sauger fishing on Trout .
 Lake, Vilas county and Balsam Lake, Polk county .

The order establishes a 15-inch minimum size limit and a daily bag
 limit of 3 on walleye and sauger in Trout Lake, Vilas County, and it
 establishes a 16-inch minimum size limit and a daily bag limit of 3
 on walleye and sauger in Balsam Lake, Polk County.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03(1)(c)3. is amended to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both) dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
3. Lake Mendota, Dane county <u>Trout lake, Vilas county</u>	First Saturday in May to March 1	3	15

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(c)4. is renumbered to be NR 20.03(1)(c)5.

SECTION 3. NR 20.03(1)(c)4. is created to read:

Kind of fish and locality	Open season (both) dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Minimum length (inches)
4. Balsam lake, Polk county	First Saturday in May to March 1	3	16

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 25, 1989.


