ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN LAKE MICHIGAN COMMERCIAL FISHING BOARD RENUMBERING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER OF renumbering s. NR 25.07

(2) (b) 1., 2. and 3.; amending s. NR 25.07

(2) (b) (title), 2.(intro.), c. and d.,

3.c. and 4.; and creating s. NR 25.07(2)

(b) 1. of the Wisconsin Administrative

Code pertaining to commercial fishing for yellow perch on Lake Michigan and Green Bay

Analysis Prepared by the Lake Michigan Commercial Fishing Board

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3), 29.33(7) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085, 29.174(1) and (2) and 29.33(1) and (7), Stats.

The rules are "housecleaning" revisions needed to correct cross references, style and format problems and to integrate the existing rules governing the yellow perch quota allocation for Green Bay with the new three zone system established by Natural Resources Board Order FM-40-88 (Clearinghouse Rule 88-173). The rules also add language in SECTION 1 to clarify that no one may fish with commercial gear for yellow perch in zone 1 unless the person has a permit from the department.

No substantive changes are made in the existing criteria for the allotment of individual licensee catch quotas or for allocation among individual fishers of yellow perch harvest limits for what had been "the Wisconsin waters of Green Bay" and is now "zone 1".

SECTION 1. NR 25.07(2)(b)(title) is amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(b)(title) Yellow perch in zone 1.

SECTION 2. NR 25.07(2)(b)1., 2. and 3. are renumbered 2., 3. and 4., respectively, and NR 25.07(2)(b)2.(intro.), c. and d., 3.c. and 4., as renumbered, are amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(b)2.(intro.) Green Bay yellow Yellow perch

FM-41-89 2

fishing permits and individual licensee catch quotas <u>for zone 1</u> shall be issued to all applicants:

- c. Who applied for and received a Green Bay yellow perch fishing permit or a yellow perch fishing permit for zone 1 for the license year preceding the license year for which the permit application is presently being made, unless unavoidable circumstances prevented application for or receipt of that previous permit. Those circumstances shall be reviewed by the Lake Michigan commercial fishing board which in these cases shall approve or deny the pending permit application.
- d. Any licensee who fails to apply for and receive a permit under this paragraph is not eligible for future Green Bay yellow perch fishing permits under this paragraph until the provisions of subd. 2.c. are applicable.
- 3.c. Any future increase of the total allowable annual commercial harvest as established by s. NR 25.06(2)(b)1. that exceeds 521,285 pounds will shall be divided equally among all licensed commercial fishers who apply for Green Bay yellow perch fishing permits for zone 1, regardless of past yellow perch harvest records.
- 4. Fishing under permits issued under subd. 1. 2. may be done from any boat listed on the permittee's commercial fishing license or through the ice.
- SECTION 3. NR 25.07(2)(b)1. is created to read:

NR 25.07(2)(b)1. No person may fish for yellow perch with

commercial gear in zone 1 unless the person has a permit for that zone issued by the department under this paragraph.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Lake Michigan Commercial Fishing Board on June 19, 1989.

The foregoing rules were approved by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 29, 1989.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided by s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
