ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
RENUMBERING, AMENDING AND CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of renumbering .
s. NR 6.03(1) to (5); amending s. NR 6.01; .
and creating ss. NR 6.03 (intro.), (3) & .
(4) and 6.09, of the Wisconsin . LE-29-89

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: s. 227.11(2)(a), Stats.
Statutes interpreted: ss. 350.09(8) and (9) and 350.12(2)(c), Stats.

This rule will provide definitions to clarify currently undefined terms found in ch. 350, Stats., relating to snowmobile races.

SECTION 1. NR 6.01 is amended to read:

NR 6.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of this chapter is to establish procedures for certification of snowmobile equipment standards pursuant to s. 350.09, Stats., and establishes requirements for snowmobile races and derbies.

SECTION 2. NR 6.03 (intro.) is created to read:

NR 6.03 DEFINITIONS. In this chapter and in ch. 350, Stats., these definitions shall apply.

SECTION 3. NR 6.03(1) to (5) are renumbered NR 6.03(5), (1), (6), (2) and (7), respectively.

SECTION 4. NR 6.03(3) and (4) are created to read:

NR 6.03(3) "Raceway facility" means an area, including a marked warmup and testing area, specifically designated by a sponsor for the purpose of conducting a sanctioned race or derby for which any required local permits have been obtained.

(4) "Sanctioned race or derby" means a competitive snowmobile event sponsored by a local unit of government, chamber of commerce, snowmobile club, promoter or similar organization.

SECTION 5. NR 6.09 is created to read:

NR 6.09 RACES AND DERBIES. The sponsor conducting a sanctioned race or derby when on the frozen surfaces of public waters shall:

(1) Make provisions to keep spectators from within 100 feet of a race or derby.

(2) Give prior notice of the race or derby to the local conservation warden or law enforcement agency having jurisdiction.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on July 27, 1989.

The rule shall take effect the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2) (intro.), Stats.
