Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats. The Order:

1. Changes the size and daily bag limits of trout and salmon on the portion of Lake Superior tributary streams receiving anadromous runs of trout or salmon to a daily bag limit of 5 in aggregate of which only 2 may be brown trout exceeding 15 inches and only 1 of which may be a rainbow trout, and minimum size limits of 8 inches for brook trout, 10 inches for brown trout, and 12 inches for rainbow trout and salmon.
2. Establishes a daily bag limit for rainbow trout of 1 fish and a minimum length limit of 28 inches for rainbow trout in Lake Superior.
3. Establishes a minimum length limit of 14 inches on largemouth bass and smallmouth bass in the Mississippi river.
4. Prohibits the use of commercial fishing gear from March 1 through May 31 in that portion of Pool 4 of the Mississippi river, Pierce county, between mile posts 780 and 797.
5. Prohibits the use of gill nets from March 1 to April 30 in that portion of the Mississippi river known as Pool 8 and its backwaters located north of the railroad tracks, east of the East Channel and south of Smith Slough and including French Slough as the east boundary, and prohibiting their use at any time in the Onalaska 9-foot channel from the railroad bridge

downstream to its confluence with the Mississippi River, Joe Lynn Slough from the railroad bridge to the Black river, and French Slough from the railroad bridge to its confluence with Joe Lynn Slough.

6. Establishes a 15-inch minimum length limit on walleyes in Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters, Wisconsin-Minnesota boundary waters except for Pool 3 of the Mississippi river, Wisconsin-Iowa boundary waters, and inland waters except for Lake Winnebago and waters upstream on the Fox river to the Highway 23 bridge at Princeton and waters upstream on the Wolf river to the Shawano dam.
7. Changes size and bag limits on trout in inland waters. Each water will be placed in 1 of 5 categories. Four of the categories have specific size and bag limits and the fifth category allows for special regulations for individual waters to allow special angling opportunities such as trophy fishing.
8. Allows backtrolling statewide.
9. Makes minor "housekeeping" changes.

SECTION 1. NR 20.015(2g) is created to read:

NR 20.015(2g) "Backtrolling" means to fish from a motor-driven boat while operating the boat in such a way that the boat is progressing toward the rear.

SECTION 2. NR 20.02(1)(d)1. is renumbered to be NR 20.02(1)(d).

SECTION 3. NR 20.02(1)(d)3. is amended to read:

SECTION 4. NR 20.03(1)(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 20.03(1)(intro.) The open seasons specified in the following table apply to fishing in open waters and fishing through the ice, except that the department shall close the season for fishing through the ice in any inland waters when it finds after scientific investigation and study that continued fishing through the ice in specified waters would result in a depletion of the supply of game fish and that a closed season is necessary to conserve the fish supply and insure the citizens of this state continued opportunities for good fishing. The closed seasons shall be put into effect by posting a notice on or in the vicinity of the shore of the waters affected. Posting is deemed by the department to be the most feasible way of notifying the public that a closed season is in effect. The closed seasons shall remain in full force and effect so long as the waters are covered with ice and so long as posting is continued. The department may also, following scientific investigation and study, establish bag limits and size limits on the individual inland waters when it finds that the taking of fish will aid in management of the fishery and insure the citizens of this state additional opportunities for good fishing. Such special regulations shall become effective only after public informational meetings are held. The department may also establish an urban fishing program by posting the open and closed

seasons on specified waters. For open seasons in specified waters see s. NR 20.04. The possession limit for each species of fish, except trout as specified in s. NR 20.03(5), shall be double the daily bag limit specified in this chapter except that no person may have in possession or under control more than the daily bag limit while on the ice or waters or while fishing in the state of Wisconsin. The measurement of all fish taken shall be in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the utmost end of the tail fin fully extended.

SECTION 10. NR 20.03(5) is created to read:

NR 20.03(5) INLAND TROUT FISHING. (a) Applicability. 1.

This subsection applies to all waters that contain trout except:

- a. Lake Michigan,
- b. Streams that flow into Lake Michigan, except the

Kewaunee river, from their mouths upstream to the first dam or lake,

c. The Kewaunee river from its mouth upstream to the third county hwy. C bridge,

d. Lake Superior, and

e. Those portions of Lake Superior tributary streams regulated under sub. (1)(f)4.

2. This subsection applies to all species of trout unless specifically stated otherwise, including lake trout and splake.

(b) Possession limits and size limits. 1. No person may possess more than 10 trout, of which no more than 5 may be a combined total of brown and rainbow trout, except that while on the water, bank or shore, no person may possess more fish than the daily bag limit established by par. (f) for category 1 to 4 waters or Table 1 for category 5 waters for that water or portion of water.

2. While on the water, bank or shore, no person may take or possess fish of a size not authorized by the size limit of par. (f) for category 1 to 4 waters or Table 1 for category 5 waters for that water or portion of water.

(c) Daily bag and size limits. While on the water, bank or shore, no person may take or possess fish not authorized by the daily bag and size limit of Table 1 for category 5 waters for

that water or portion of water.

(d) Open seasons. No person may fish for trout in any water or portion of any water except during the open season for that water or portion of water established by Table 1 or this paragraph. Where an open season for trout is not specified in Table 1 for a water or portion of water the open season is the first Saturday in May at 5:00 a.m. to September 30, both dates inclusive.

(e) Gear restrictions. While fishing on a category 5 water, no person may use gear not authorized by a gear restriction listed in Table 1 for that water or portion of water.

(f) Regulation categories. Waters that contain trout are divided into 5 categories of regulation. The categories and corresponding regulations are:

1. Category 1 - no minimum size limit and a daily bag limit of 10 fish, of which no more than 5 may be a combined total of brown and rainbow trout.

2. Category 2 - the minimum size limit is 7 inches and the daily bag limit is 5 fish.

3. Category 3 - the minimum size limit is 9 inches and the daily bag limit is 3 fish.

4. Category 4 - the minimum size limit is 12 inches for brown and rainbow trout and 8 inches for brook trout and the daily bag limit is 3 fish.

5. Category 5 - see Table 1, which sets out size limits, daily bag limits, daily bag and size limits, open seasons and gear restrictions for each specific water or portion of water.

(g) Key to Table 1. Table 1 lists waters and portions of waters by county, water name and portion of water and the regulation category that applies. It sets out the exceptions to the general open season prescribed in par. (d), and it prescribes specific regulations for category 5 waters.

SECTION 12. NR 20.06(1)(b)(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 20.06(1)(b) Trolling. (intro.) No person may fish in the inland waters of the state from a motor-driven boat when the motor is running or from any sailboat when in motion; or by means of shutting or drawing off water for that purpose unless the person is backtrolling. Casting and immediate retrieval of a bait or lure while positioning a boat by means of an electric motor, where motors are permitted, is not trolling. The restrictions in this paragraph do not apply to the waters of Barron, Bayfield, Burnett, Douglas, Polk, Racine, Rusk, Taylor, Washburn and Waukesha counties, the Wisconsin river including sloughs, bayous and flowages from county trunk A east of

Tomahawk, Lincoln County, downstream, except Lake Mohawksin, the Chippewa river including sloughs, bayous and flowages up to the flowing portion of all tributary streams from the Holcombe flowage, Chippewa county, downstream, the Fox river from Buffalo lake downstream to the DePere dam and the following named lakes and rivers including their flowages and sloughs:


