ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of repealing and recreating  
ss. NR 10.01(2)(f)1. and 2. and 10.29  
pertaining to 1990 wild turkey hunting  
regulations.

WM-48-89

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.103, 29.174(3) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.103, and 29.174(2)(b), Stats.

1. Wild turkey harvest levels are established based on desired hunter numbers increasing the 1990 permit level to 33,840 from the 1989 level of 21,280.
2. Three new hunting zones are opened to turkey hunting due to expanding turkey populations.
3. The spring turkey hunting season is modified as follows:
  - a. Open on Wednesday nearest April 13, rather than Wednesday nearest April 21.
  - b. Extend the season length to 6 consecutive Wednesday through Sunday (5-day) periods rather than 4.



NR 10.01(2)(f)1. Zones identified in subd. 2. and Ft. McCoy military reservation in Monroe county are open to turkey hunting by permit. The remainder of the state is closed to turkey hunting.	Spring season beginning on Wednesday nearest April 13 and continuing Wednesday through Sunday for 6 consecutive 5-day time periods, except on Ft. McCoy military reservation where the season may continue for 40 consecutive days.	One male or bearded turkey per season by permit.
