

ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
CREATING RULES

The Public Service Commission herein creates
s. PSC 165.081(6), and s. PSC 165.055(6), Wis. Adm. Code,
requiring local exchange telecommunications utilities to provide
and publicize single-party revertive calling capability.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

On March 29, and June 20, 1989, the Commission held
hearings concerning a proposed rule requiring local exchange
telecommunications utilities to provide and publicize
single-party revertive calling capability. The hearings resulted
from the Commission's order in docket 05-TI-114 (January 13, 1989),
in which this agency ordered local exchange telecommunications
utilities in Wisconsin to provide and publicize single-party
revertive calling as a part of basic telephone service.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service
Commission by ss. 196.02, 196.26, 196.28, and 227.11(2)(a),

capability. Directories covering numerous exchanges or wire centers with different dialing instructions for use of single-party revertive calling capability, may direct customers to call the utility for such instructions in lieu of including the instructions.

There will be no fiscal impact of this proposed rule on state or local units of government, or on small businesses.

This is a Type 3 action pursuant to s. PSC 2.90(3), Wis. Adm. Code. In addition, no unusual circumstances have come to the attention of the Commission which would warrant further environmental review. It consequently requires neither an environmental impact statement under s. 1.11, Stats., nor an environmental assessment.


EFFECTIVE DATE
