

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN
NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending s. NR 485.01(1) . AM-47-89
and Table 1 in s. NR 485.04(1) of the .
Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining .
to emission limitations for motor .

Statutory authority: ss. 144.31(1)(a), 144.38, 144.42(2), and
227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 144.31(1)(f), 144.38, and 144.42(2),
Stats.

This rule establishes emission limitations for motor vehicles of model year 1990 and newer. These limitations will be used as the standards for vehicles tested under the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance program established under s. 110.20, Stats. This program is currently operating in six southeastern Wisconsin counties (Kenosha, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Racine, Washington, and Waukesha).

Currently the program has emission limitations for motor vehicles of model years 1970 to 1989 only. This rule does not change any of the emission limitations for these model years.

This rule also eliminates redundant language from s. NR 485.01(1), Wis. Adm. Code, to improve the section's readability.

SECTION 1. NR 485.01(1) is amended to read:

NR 485.01(1) APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies to all motor vehicles, internal combustion engines and mobile air contaminant sources and to ~~all their owners or operators of a motor vehicle,~~ ~~internal combustion engine or mobile air contaminant source.~~

SECTION 2. Table 1 in NR 485.04(1) is amended to read:


