ORDER

The Medical Examining Board proposes an order to amend section Med 10.02 (2) (s) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relating to the use of any amphetamine, sympathomimetic amine drug or compound designated as a schedule II controlled substance under s. 161.16 (5), Stats.

Analysis prepared by the Department of Regulation and Licensing.

ANALYSIS

Statutory authority: ss. 15.08(5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a), 448.01 (11), and s. 448.40, Stats.

Statute interpreted: 448.02 and 448.05

In this rulemaking order the Medical Examining Board proposes to amend a rule regulating the use of amphetamines to permit the use of these drugs with analgesic compounds under a recognized protocol for treatment of cancer-related pain.

TEXT OF RULE

Section 1. Med 10.02 (2) (s) is amended to read:

- (s) Prescribing, ordering, dispensing, administering, supplying, selling, or giving any amphetamine, sympathomimetic amine drug or compound designated as a schedule II controlled substance pursuant to the provisions of $eh_{\tau}161 s. 161.16 (5)$, Stats. to or for any person except for any of the following:
- Use as an adjunct to opioid analgesic compounds for treatment of cancer-related pain,
 - 2. the-treatment Treatment of narcolepsy,
 - <u>3.</u> er-fer-the treatment Treatment of hyperkinesis,
- or-for-the-treatment Treatment of drug induced brain dysfunction,

- 5. or-for-the-treatment Treatment of epilepsy,
- $\underline{6.}$ or-for-the-differential Differential diagnostic psychiatric evaluation of depression,
- 7. er-fer-the-treatment Treatment of depression shown to be refractory to other therapeutic modalities,
- 8. or-for-the-elimical <u>Clinical</u> investigation of the effects of such drugs or compounds in which case an investigative protocol therefore shall have been submitted to and reviewed and approved by the board before such investigation has been begun.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (intro), Stats.
