

1. Extends the special Lake Mendota regulations to the following tributary waters: Cherokee Lake; Warner Park Lagoons; Pheasant Branch Creek from its mouth upstream to Dane County Hwy. M; Sixmile Creek from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19 in Sec. 8; and Yahara River from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19. The special regulations include a 15 inch minimum size limit on walleyes, a bag limit of 3 walleyes and a minimum size limit of 32 inches and a bag limit of one fish on northern pike.
2. Increases the minimum size limit on walleyes from 15 to 18 inches beginning on the first Saturday in May 1991 in Lake Mendota and the following tributary waters: Cherokee Lake; Warner Park Lagoons; Pheasant Branch Creek from its mouth upstream to Dane County Hwy. M; Sixmile Creek from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19 in Sec. 8; and Yahara River from its mouth upstream to State Hwy. 19.


