ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
 REPEALING, RENUMBERING, AMENDING, AND RECREATING AND CREATING RULES

Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174(3) and 227.11(2)(a) and (d), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(c), Stats.

The proposed rules establish a new Canada goose hunting zone for southeastern Wisconsin and establish a September 1-10 hunting season. A permit is required to participate in this new season and all participants must file a goose hunting report. Participants are eligible to take part in other Canada goose hunting seasons.

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(1)(g)1.m. is created to read:

Kind of animal	Locality	Open season (all dates inclusive)	Daily bag limit	Possession limit
	m. Early goose hunt sub zone	September 1-10, excluding the Saturday, Sunday and Monday of Labor Day weekend	5	10

SECTION 2. NR 10.125(1)(b) and (d) through (e) are repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.125(1)(b) Validity. 1. Except as provided under subd. 2, permits and any associated carcass tags are valid only in the zones and for the time periods specified on the permit during the open season established for Canada geese.

2. Horicon zone permit holders possessing a current, valid permit with an unused carcass tag may hunt in the Theresa zone beginning the day after the date on which the Theresa zone harvest quota is reached and continuing through the end of Theresa zone season.

(d) Application and issuance procedures; all zones. 1. Applications shall be on forms supplied by the department and, except early goose hunt subzone applications, shall include the applicant's senior citizen recreation card number, hunter education certificate number, armed forces license number or bow license number.

2. No person may submit more than one application per year except that:

a. Persons not applying by the permit application deadline for the Collins, Horicon, Theresa or Pine Island zones established under par. (e) may reapply, provided the goose season is open, for a Exterior zone permit.

b. Persons applying for an early goose hunt subzone permit may also apply for a Collins, Horicon, Theresa, Pine Island or Exterior zone permit.

3. Applicants may indicate preference for any zone and period.

4. No person may submit an application containing false information.

(e) Application and issuance procedures; Collins, Horicon, Pine Island and Theresa zones. 1. 'Deadline.' Collins, Horicon, Pine Island and Theresa zone applications shall be postmarked no later than the first Friday in September or hand delivered to the department license section no later than 4:30 p.m. on that Friday each year.

Note: The license section address is 101 South Webster, Box 7924, Madison, WI 53707.

2. 'Group applications.' If 2 or more persons wish to hunt together in the Collins, Horicon or Pine Island zones, each shall fill out an application form and submit them together in one envelope clearly marked "group application" on the outside. A group application shall be considered one application.

3. 'Preference.' When Collins, Horicon or Pine Island applications exceed the number of permits available, successful applicants shall be randomly selected with first preference given to persons who unsuccessfully applied for a permit during the previous year.

4. 'Multiple tags.' If the number of Collins, Horicon or Pine Island zone permit applications is less than the number of permits available for any time period, the department may issue the remaining permits to successful applicants by random selection and increase the applicant's season bag limit accordingly.

(f) Application and issuance procedures; Exterior zone. Exterior zone permit applications may be obtained by mail or in person at department district and area offices during normal office hours throughout the open season.

Note: Normal office hours are 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

(g) Application and issuance procedures; Early goose hunt subzone. Early goose hunt subzone applications shall be postmarked no later than the first Friday in August or hand delivered to the department license section no later than 4:30 p.m. on that Friday each year.

(h) Permit validation procedures. In the Exterior zones, when a Canada goose is taken and before it is transported in any manner, the hunter shall validate the permit by slitting or punching the mark indicating the month and day the goose was killed. Failure to follow the validation procedure invalidates the permit and renders any goose in possession illegal.

SECTION 3. NR 10.125(5)(a) as amended in CHR 89-120 is amended to read:

NR 10.125(5)(a) Report card issuance. Canada goose harvest reports shall be issued to each successful applicant for the Early goose hunt and Exterior zone zones. Exterior zone permit holders shall be issued 5 report cards. Additional report cards may be issued at department district and

area offices to applicants appearing in person.

SECTION 4. NR 10.125(5)(a)2. is repealed.

SECTION 5. NR 10.125(5)(b) is renumbered to 10.125(5)(b)1.

SECTION 6. NR 10.125(5)(b)1.(title) is created to read:

NR 10.125(5)(b)1. Exterior Zone.

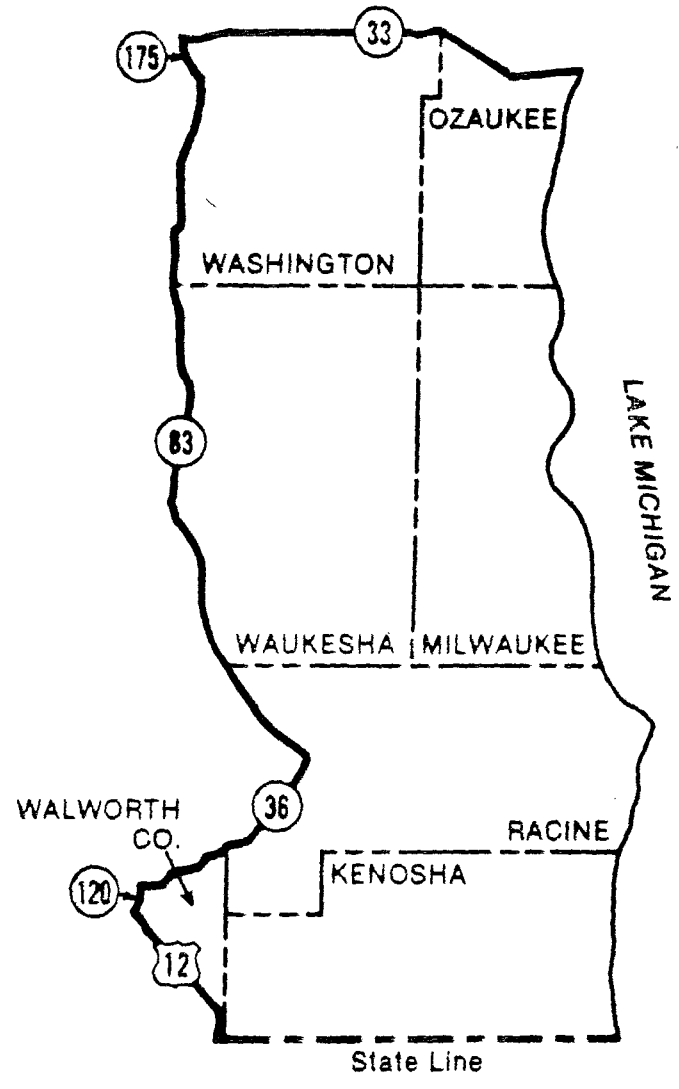
SECTION 7. NR 10.125(5)(b)2. is created to read:

NR 10.125(5)(b)2. Early goose hunt subzone. Each Early goose hunt subzone permittee shall complete and submit a department harvest report form to the department within 48 hours of the close of the season.

SECTION 9. NR 10.31(11) is created to read:

NR 10.31(11) EARLY GOOSE HUNT SUBZONE.


