

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory Authority: ss. 29.103, 29.174(2)(b) and 227.16(2)(e), Stats.  
Statutes Interpreted: s. 29.103, Stats.

The proposed rules:

1. Establish permit levels for the 1990 fall turkey season.
2. Open 4 additional turkey hunting zones for fall 1990 turkey hunting.
3. Change the fall hunting season framework from 3 5-day split seasons to 3 consecutive 7-day seasons beginning on the second Monday of October.
4. Prohibit the hunting of wild turkeys over bait.

SECTION 1. NR 10.01(2)(f)2. and 3. are repealed and recreated to read:

SECTION 2. NR 10.25(4)(e) is created to read:

NR 10.25(4)(e) With the aid of bait.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on March 1, 1990.

The rules shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22 (2)(intro.), Stats.


