

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ORDER

An order to repeal RL 10.01 (7); to amend RL 10.03 and to repeal and recreate RL 10.03 (2) of the administrative code relating to examinations to use diagnostic pharmaceutical agents.

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ANALYSIS

Statutory authority: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) (a), Stats.  
Statutes interpreted: s. 449.17, Stats.

In this order the Department of Regulation and Licensing is amending RL 10.03 by adding a note relating to the administration and scoring of the pharmacology examination and repealing and recreating RL 10.03 (2) to specify the minimum score an applicant must have in the pharmacology section of the examination before that person may obtain certification to use diagnostic pharmaceutical agents. The new RL 10.03 (2) and the note define the pharmacology examination, therefore the definition of "examination in pharmacology" found at RL 10.01 (7) is being repealed.

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TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. RL 10.01 (7) is repealed.

SECTION 2. RL 10.03 (2) is repealed and recreated to read:

RL 10.03 (2) Obtained a score of no less than 75 on the examination in pharmacology which is administered by the national board of examiners in optometry; and,

SECTION 3. The following NOTE is inserted after RL 10.03 (3):

NOTE: The Department of Regulation and Licensing does not administer the pharmacology examination. The required score of "no less than 75" relates only to the pharmacology section of the national examination. Therefore, if all sections of the national examination are taken at once, the 75 score minimum applies only to the pharmacology section and not to the other sections of the examination.

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, pursuant to s. 227.22(2)(intro), Stats.
