#### Analysis Prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 144.025(2) and 227.11(2)(a) and ch. 160, Stats. Statutes interpreted: s. 144.025(2) and ch. 160, Stats.

Chapter 160, Stats., requires the Department to develop numerical groundwater quality standards, consisting of enforcement standards and preventive action limits. Chapter NR 140, Wis. Adm. Code, establishes groundwater standards and creates a framework for implementation of the standards by the Department. The proposed amendments to ch. NR 140 would change total dissolved solids (TDS) from a welfare parameter to an indicator parameter.

SECTION 1. NR 140.12, Table 2 is amended to read:
