

ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION
AMENDING RULES

To amend s. PSC 2.04(1), relating to the furnishing of
copies of Public Service Commission decisions.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

S. PSC 2.04(1), Wis. Adm. Code presently provides that
certified copies of a Commission decision shall be issued to all
parties. For administrative convenience, the Commission proposes
to remove the word "certified" from the rule, which will remain
unchanged in all other respects. Certification of copies will
remain available upon specific request. The change will be made
without hearing, unless one is requested.

RULES AND STATUTORY AUTHORITY

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service
Commission by ss. 196.02(3) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats., and
interpreting those provisions, the Public Service Commission
proposes to amend s. PSC 2.04(1) as follows:

SECTION 1: S. PSC 2.04(1) is amended to read:

PSC 2.04 FURNISHING COPIES OF RECORDS. (1) One certified
copy of the decision in a proceeding will be furnished free of
charge at the time of issuance to each party of record, except
that when a party of record is represented by counsel, a copy of
the decision will be furnished to the party's counsel. When a
municipal utility is a party of record to a proceeding, a copy of
the decision will be furnished both to the management of the
utility and to the appropriate official of the municipality free
of charge at the time of issuance. Certified copies will be
provided on request.
