ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
CREATING RULES

IN THE MATTER of creating s. NR 20.015 (4b)  
of the Wisconsin Administrative Code  
pertaining to creating a definition of . LE-51-90  
openly exposed as it relates to the .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Authorizing statutes: ss. 29.174(3), 227.11(2)(a) and 227.16, Stats.  
Statutes interpreted: s. 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

There is a term in the current rules that is considered by some courts and prosecutors to be vague. In many instances, this vagueness results in unnecessary litigation.

This change involves establishing a definition for openly exposed as it relates to the transportation of sturgeon. This definition is consistent with the same term found in the deer and bear hunting rules.

SECTION 1. NR 20.015(4b) is created to read:

NR 20.015(4b) DEFINITIONS. "Openly exposed" means open to view by a person in a passing vehicle.

The foregoing rule was approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on August 23, 1990.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


