Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: s. 227.11(2)(a), Stats.
Statutes interpreted: s. 27.01(2)(c), Stats.

NR 1.30(2) does not permit overnight lodging facilities in state parks other than designated campgrounds, group camps, or staff residences.

The Department has a Memorandum of Understanding partnership with the Telephone Pioneers of America, Wisconsin Chapter No. 4, a nationwide philanthropic organization, to remove barriers, enhance existing facilities, and provide new opportunities for parks and forests visitors with physical disabilities. One of the goals of the Memorandum of Understanding is for the Telephone Pioneers of America organization to construct and gift to the Department a cabin-like building in the Mirror Lake State Park family campground for use exclusively by people with disabilities who generally cannot participate in a traditional camping experience.

The Department also has an agreement with the Seth Peterson Conservancy, Inc., to restore, preserve, and use the Frank Lloyd Wright designed Seth Peterson cottage at Mirror Lake State Park. Overnight lodging is one of the proposed uses.

NR 1.30(2) must be amended to permit overnight lodging in these two specific Mirror Lake State Park facilities.

SECTION 1. NR 1.30(2) is amended to read:

NR 1.30(2) No overnight lodging facilities other than designated campgrounds, group camps, and staff residences shall be constructed in state parks, except for a cabin constructed for use exclusively by people with physical disabilities, with their family or attendant or both and overnight lodging in the Seth Peterson cottage, both at Mirror Lake state park.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on October 25, 1990.

The rules shall take effect the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.


