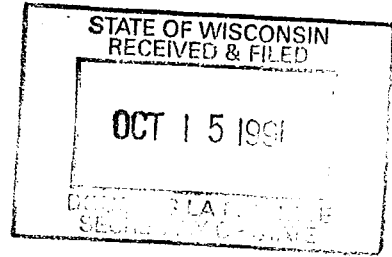



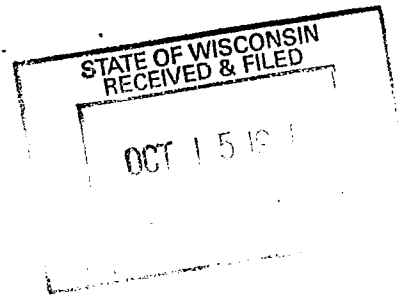

ORDER OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

REPEALING A RULE

To repeal Ins 6.79 (2) (c) relating to abolishing the financial advisory council.

ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Statutory authority: ss. 601.41 (3), 15.04 (1) (c), and 601.20 (1), Stats.


Statutes Interpreted: s. 15.04 (1) (c), Stats.

The rule abolishes the financial advisory council. The financial advisory council has met infrequently over the past several years and has had difficulty formulating substantive agendas. Financial issues which need to be raised can be addressed formally through either the life and disability council or the property and casualty council and informally through other avenues.

SECTION 1. Ins 6.79 (2) (c) is repealed.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This rule will take effect on the first day of the first month after publication, as provided in s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
