The Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations proposes an order to repeal ILHR 87.10 (5); to renumber ch. NR 124; to amend ILHR 87.10 (2), (6) and (7); to repeal and recreate ILHR 87.03 (1), (8) and (10), and 87.07 (1) Note; and to create ILHR 87.10 (7) Note, relating to private sewage system replacement or rehabilitation grant program.

ANALYSIS OF RULES

Statutory authority: ss. 101.02 and 145.02 (3), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 145.245, Stats.

The enactment of 1991 Wisconsin Act 39 transferred the administration and enforcement of the private sewage system replacement or rehabilitation grant program from the Department of Natural Resources to the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations. The proposed rule revisions are intended to reflect this procedural change by renumbering the existing rules of ch. NR 124 to ch. ILHR 87 and incorporating the renumbered chapter as part of the plumbing code. The revisions also correct several definitions and cross references to the statutes and administrative rules.

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- SECTION 1. Chapter NR 124 is renumbered ch. ILHR 87.
- SECTION 2. ILHR 87.03 (1), (8) and (10) as renumbered are repealed and recreated to read:

ILHR 87.03 (1) "Department" means the department of industry, labor and human relations.

- (8) "Private sewage system" has the meaning as given in 145.01 (12), Stats.
- (10) "State plumbing code" means chs. ILHR 81 to 87.
- SECTION 3. ILHR 87.07 (1) Note as renumbered is repealed and recreated to read:

ILHR 87.07 (1) Note: Application forms may be obtained, at no charge, from the Bureau of Building Water Systems, Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations, P.O. Box 7969, Madison, Wisconsin 53707.

SECTION 4. ILHR 87.10 (2) as renumbered is amended to read:

ILHR 87.10 (2) Under s. 144/98//8tats// 145.02, Stats., the department may terminate or annul a grant made under this section and seek recovery of some or all grant funds previously paid to the participating governmental unit, if an order issued under s. 144/245/(14)/(8tats//145.245) (14), Stats., is violated.

- SECTION 5. ILHR 87.10 (5) as renumbered is repealed.
- SECTION 6. ILHR 87.10 (6) and (7) as renumbered are amended to read:

ILHR 87.10 (6) The department may seek an injunction or other appropriate relief under s. 144/98/81418/145.02 (3) (f), Stats.

- (7) The department may seek the imposition of a forfeiture for each violation, pursuant to s. IAA/99//Stats/ 145.245 (15) Stats.
- SECTION 7. ILHR 87.10 (7) Note is created to read:

ILHR 87.10 (7) Note: Section 145.245 (15) reads: Any person who violates this section or a rule or order promulgated under this section shall forfeit not less than \$10 nor more than \$5,000 for each violation. Each day of continued violation is a separate offense. While an order is suspended, stayed or enjoined, this penalty does not accrue.
