ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING RULES

IN THE MATTER of amending ss. NR 25.06(2)(a) .

1. and 2. and (e)2. and 25.07(2)(a)2.a. of
the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining .
to annual chub and whitefish quotas for
commercial fishing in Green Bay and Lake .

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 23.09(2)(intro), 23.11(1), 29.174(2)(a), 29.33(1) and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 23.09(1), 29.174(1) and 29.33(1), Stats.

The order increases the annual commercial fishing quotas for chubs and whitefish in Green Bay and Lake Michigan. SECTIONS 1 and 3 of the order increase the total allowable harvest for chubs in the northern chub fishing zone by 100,000 pounds with 50,000 pounds allocated to the October 1 to January 15 period and 50,000 pounds to the March 1 to June 30 period. An obsolete reference to forage fish is also deleted. SECTION 2 of the order increases the total allowable harvest for whitefish by 150,000 pounds, with 13,695 pounds allocated to zone 1, 123,255 pounds to zone 2, and 13,050 pounds to zone 3.

SECTION 1. NR 25.06(2)(a)1. and 2. are amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(a)1. The total allowable commercial harvest for any license year may not exceed 3,500,000 3,600,000 pounds, not including forage fish allowed under par.(c).

2. No more than 400,000 500,000 pounds of the total allowable commercial harvest for any license year may be taken in the northern chub fishing zone.

SECTION 2. NR 25.06(2)(e)2. is amended to read:

NR 25.06(2)(e)2. The total allowable commercial harvest of whitefish in Lake Michigan and Green Bay may not exceed $\frac{1,150,000}{1}$

1,300,000 pounds in any license year, with no more than 105,000 118,695 pounds to be taken in zone 1, 945,000 1,068,255 pounds from zone 2, and 100,000 113,050 pounds from zone 3.

SECTION 3. NR 25.07(2)(a)2.a. is amended to read:

NR 25.07(2)(a)2.a. No more than 100,000 pounds of chubs may be harvested during the period of July 1 through September 30; no more than 200,000 250,000 pounds of chubs may be harvested during the quota period of October 1 through January 15 except that this amount shall be adjusted to include the portion of the allowable harvest for the previous period not reported as harvested in that period; and no more than 100,000 150,000 pounds of chubs may be harvested during the quota period of March 1 through June 30 except that the amount shall be adjusted to include the portion of the allowable harvest for the previous period that is not reported as harvested in that period.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on December 12, 1991

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register, as provided by s. 227.22(2)(intro.), Stats.
