An order of the Chiropractic Examining Board to create Chir 5.01 (1m) of the administrative code relating to continuing education requirements for chiropractors.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5), 227.11 (2) (a) and 446.02 (1) (b), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: s. 446.02 (1) (b), Stats.

In this order, the Chiropractic Examining Board increases the continuing education hours required of chiropractors from 24 hours in each biennial registration period to 40 hours in each biennial registration period, beginning with the registration period commencing January 1, 1993. The board believes that additional continuing education is required for chiropractors to maintain currency in an increasingly complex and volatile health care environment.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Chir 5.01 (1m) is created to read:

Chir 5.01 (1m) Every chiropractor shall complete at least 40 contact hours in approved continuing education programs in each biennial registration period beginning on and after January 1, 1993, except as specified in s. Chir 3.02 (1) (c).

The rules adopted in this order shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin administrative register pursuant to s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.
